The newest offering from Tasmanian Leaders is a sure-fire way to fast track your leadership vision and impact. Leading Change in the West is highly experiential. It is designed to provide participants with practical skills in leadership and creative problem solving. Participants will explore local issues through a series of site tours, before going through a design thinking process to deliver projects, in small teams, that aim to positively influence the region's future.

Benefits

- Better understand themselves as leaders and collaborators
- Have the skills and confidence to communicate with and lead others
- Be able to think strategically and long-term to influence the region's future
- Develop a wider network and community of relevant peers

Structure

The program, delivered over 2.5 days in a residential setting, will include a mixture of facilitator led workshops and sector expertise. The program will conclude with a formal event to highlight outcomes from each of the projects.

In between the initial residential and the presentations, facilitators, Don Thomson and Angela Driver, will provide project teams the opportunity to undertake a further training session delivered on-line in project teams.

Program Fees

In 2019 the cost of the program is covered by the University of Tasmania and will be offered free to those living in the West Coast Municipality.
