The Drought Resilience Leaders Development program is an initiative funded under the Australian Government's Future Drought Fund and supports rural communities across Australia to prepare for impacts of future droughts and climate change overall.

The Australian Rural Leadership Foundation is partnering with Tasmanian Leaders to deliver the program for people living on the Tasmanian east coast and Flinders Island.

It is for anyone, above the age of 18, interested in building long-term drought and climate resilience by working with people from different backgrounds.

Learning outcomes

The activities on this program are based on the Australian Rural Leadership Foundation's 30-year old experiential learning method and give you an understanding of leadership as a practice rather than a title or role.

While it might take you out of your comfort zone a little and test your resilience and collaboration skills, this program equips you with skills to manage challenging situations and be prepared to step up in real life. All activities are based on scenarios specific to your region to give you a deeper understanding of your community. Because your fellow participants come from different backgrounds, you'll get better at working with others, even if they have opposing opinions.

You emerge from the program connected to a network of up to 40 forward-thinkers ready to drive positive change and have the skills build more strong networks to achieve better outcomes and solve problems.
