Industry, Leadership, Enterprise and Development

There has never been a better time to **invest in your leadership development** to help Tasmania's tourism and hospitality sector thrive.

Tasmanian Leaders' high-impact Industry, Leadership, Enterprise and Development (I-LEAD) program is currently inviting applications from Tasmania's tourism and hospitality sector.

This is a unique opportunity to increase your leadership capacity and influence. It will suit emerging and established leaders from both large and enterprises.

I-LEAD Tourism & Hospitality will be delivered across eight sessions, between May and July, with **three full-day in-person events** (beginning, middle and end of program) and **five half-day sessions delivered online**.

The weekly rhythm enables participants to apply learnings between sessions including new behavioural choices, and to test previously held assumptions, as their learnings become integrated. The in-person sessions maximise connections with the cohort, while the online components minimise disruption to participants work flow.

Content will be delivered by Tasmanian Leaders expert facilitators alongside industry professionals to provide relevant expertise and insights.

The program is designed to respond to the current needs of the Tasmanian tourism and hospitality sector and broadly fits under three key areas:

Personal leadership

- Better understand social motivators and drivers of behaviour.
- Elevate your sense of purpose, leadership style and personal wellbeing.

Adaptive leadership

- Develop tools for leading in complex, ambiguous and uncertain environments.
- Gain greater influence to improve business performance and outcomes.

Strategic leadership

- Improve your capacity to lead across boundaries to generate sector level change.
- Develop deeper insights and stronger networks for a thriving tourism and hospitality sector.

Outcomes

By the end of the program participants can:

- Better understand themselves as leaders
- Think strategically to better influence business outcomes
- Have a wider network of relevant industry peers
- Be inspired to lead beyond self for the greater good of Tasmania's tourism and hospitality industry

Registration will be successful based on meeting the following criteria:

- Employment in, or ownership of, a Tasmanian tourism or hospitality enterprise
- Commitment to participate in the program and work with, learn from, and share with others
- Potential to contribute to the tourism and hospitality industry and Tasmania on graduation from the program
- Demonstrated leadership experience or ambition, and achievement to date

Program fees

The I-LEAD Tourism & Hospitality program is generously subsidised from the regular investment of \$1,795, down to **\$795** per participant with thanks to support from the Federal Group and Tasmanian Hospitality Association.
