Enrol today to discover proven strategies to enhance your leadership skills, understand the psychology of human behaviour, and refine your leadership style. Learn how to motivate others, influence decision-making, and unlock your potential to bring out the best in yourself and your team.

The program runs from August to late September 2026, featuring eight engaging sessions that blend in-person workshops in Launceston and Hobart with six dynamic online sessions.

Designed to fit busy schedules and support regional participation, weekly online gatherings allow you to apply insights immediately and stay on track for success.
