Tasmanian Leaders® is Tasmania's premier leadership development organisation.

For almost two decades, Tasmanian Leaders has strengthened the State's leadership capacity by developing people who can navigate complexity, work across boundaries, and create positive change.

TASMANIAN LEADERS PROGRAM

Our flagship Tasmanian Leaders Program (TLP) is a world-class, intensive year-long undertaking for 24 high-potential participants, focused on building leadership capacity and connectivity across all sectors.

Funded by the Tasmanian Government through the Department of State Growth, this program is a unique opportunity to deepen your leadership capability and build powerful, long-lasting networks across Tasmania.

Widely described as life-changing and professionally transformative, it is best suited to established and experienced leaders, or those operating at a senior level of influence, who want to lift their impact and help shape a better future for the State.

The program delivers meaningful outcomes for participants, their organisations and the wider community. Delivered intensively from February to November, the Tasmanian Leaders Program blends multi-day Residential, two- to three- day Linking Sessions, and Community Action Projects to strengthen participants' ability to lead in complex environments.

This program is ideal for people who want to learn leadership while gaining a deeper understanding of the challenges and opportunities facing Tasmania. Through immersive, experiential learning - from industry visits to time spent with community - participants develop insight, perspective and the motivation to lead with impact.

I-LEAD Women in Community Services

Funded by the Department of Premier and Cabinet, I-LEAD Women in Community Services supports women working or volunteering at the heart of Tasmania's community sector.

Gain the leadership skills needed to tackle challenges, drive change, strengthen governance, and lead collaboratively for lasting impact.

The I-LEAD Women in Community Services program will run May to July 2026 at the subsidised price of \$655.

I-LEAD Young Professionals

Supported by Federal Hospitality, I-LEAD Young Professionals is specifically tailored for people under 35 years of age from all sectors and professions.

Learn proven pathways to increase your leadership skills, influence decision making and unlock your potential. Bring out the best in yourself and your team, with a focus on leadership psychology, influence and communication.

I-LEAD Young Professionals runs from August to September. Investment per person is \$2,499 and includes the opportunity for mentoring.

I-LEAD Equality

Designed for LGBTIQA+ community members and allies, I-LEAD Equality builds the confidence, skills and connections needed to lead with pride and influence.

Supported by the Tasmanian Community Fund and the Winifred Booth Charitable Trust, this eight-week program strengthens participants' capacity to navigate complexity, advocate for inclusion and create safer, more equitable environments across workplaces and communities.

It offers a supportive cohort experience, practical tools and a powerful space to grow as a leader committed to equality.

Uncovering the power of women leaders in Tasmania's male-dominated industries, this program accelerates your leadership, builds decision-making skills, and connects you with other women to advance gender equality and drive meaningful change.
